PROPOSED CONTEST RULE FOR THE LIONISTIC YEAR 2023-2024

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE CONTEST

- a. Period of Contest: 11 months from 1st July 2023 to 31st May 2024
- b. For Membership and WMMR from 1st July 2023 to 30th June 2024
- c. For the purpose of Contest, Clubs are grouped into 4 categories as follows:

(Membership based as on 1st July 2023)

- Group A Clubs having Membership 45 and above
- Group B Clubs having Membership from 31 to 44
- Group C Clubs having Membership from 20 to 30
- Group D –Clubs with membership below 20 and New Clubs Inaugurated after 1st July 2023
- d. Points will be awarded for the activities reported through the Monthly Activity Reports only. Please ensure that all activities are reported along with the WMMR, even if reported separately.
- e. To claim points for a Service Activity, details including the postal address of the Beneficiary along with the photograph of the activity may be appended.
 - This is to prepare a data bank of beneficiaries of the Lionistic Year in the format approved
- f. Clubs having arrears of International Dues of more than US\$ 50 over 90 days Outstanding at the end of the 30th June 2024 and or having any arrears of the District/Multiple District on the said date shall not be eligible for any awards for the Lionstic Year 2023 2024.
